Angela Merkel, German Chancellor visits Solar Plant at Dwarka Sector- 21

New Delhi/November 02

Ms. Angela Merkel, Chancellor of Germany, visited DMRC's first roof top solar power plant installed in 2014 at Dwarka Sector - 21 metro station. The plant has been in operation for more than 05 years and has generated 3.3 Million units since commissioning, thereby meeting nearly 35% of the energy requirement of the station.

This plant is a shining example of Indo - German collaboration in the field of renewable energy. During the visit, she was accompanied by Ms. Julia Klockner, Minister for Food & Agriculture, Germany.

DMRC had installed 500 kWp solar plant on the roof of this metro station in 2014, based on the feasibility report prepared by GIZ, Germany and vetted by Lehmeier



International, Germany.

In October 2012, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by DMRC with GIZ (Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit), a Non-Profit group of Germany to develop a feasible business model using solar photovoltaic technology for electricity generation and

demonstration. GIZ had surveyed DMRC premises, & prepared reports for three sample sites (Yamuna Bank Depot for Inclined Roof, Yamuna Bank metro station for Curved Roof, and Dwarka Sector - 21 metro station for Flat Roof).

Successful implementation of this pilot project of 500 kWp capacity with the support of Solar

Energy Corporation of India, paved way for many more Solar Roof Top installations and till date 32.4 MWp of roof-top solar capacity has been commissioned on DMRC premises in Delhi and NCR.

This rooftop capacity of 32.4 MWp is spread over 14 metro train depots, 61 metro stations and 3 residential complexes of DMRC. All these are on RESCO model, where

No capital investment is made by DMRC. The installed capacity of 32.4 MWp will cut down CO2 emissions by nearly 34,000 tonnes per year and this solar project is registered under Clean Development Mechanism with UNFCCC and will earn carbon credits for DMRC.

Keeping in view the alarming pollution level in the city, visit of German Chancellor to the solar plant installed on a public transport network, puts the spot light back on the need of using clean energy and to identify steps to cut down emissions.

Ola, Uber to deactivate surge pricing during odd-even scheme in Delhi

Cab aggregators Ola and Uber have said that they will not resort to surge pricing during the 12-day odd-even road rationing scheme starting from November 4. In a statement issued on Saturday, Ola said it will extend its support to the Delhi government's initiative to curb pollution. The implementation of the odd-even scheme offers an opportunity to further unlock the potential of shared mobility. "Continuing our efforts to provide commuters an optimum and seamless experience, we will have no peak pricing on rides booked on the Ola platform during the odd-even period. We encourage all driver-partners, passengers, and citizens to participate and make the third edition of the scheme, a success," Arun Srinivas, the chief sales and marketing officer at Ola, said. Last month, Uber had announced to deactivate surge pricing during the implementation of odd-even scheme in the national capital. "We want to do our part in ensuring movement around the city is easy during the odd-even phase and have decided to deactivate dynamic pricing for the duration. We wholeheartedly support Delhi government's move and wish it success," an Uber spokesperson told Media last month. The odd-even scheme is a much needed step to reduce pollution and help reduce congestion in the capital, the spokesperson said. On Friday, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal had said that surge pricing would not be applied by app-based cabs during the odd-even scheme. According to the Delhi government, advisories have also been issued to autorickshaws and e-rickshaws to avoid over-charging from commuters. Ola spokesperson said the company will also work closely with its driver-partners to ensure maximum availability of vehicles during peak hours as well as during the staggered office timings. The odd-even scheme was notified on Friday by the Delhi government. Odd and even numbered (last digit of registration number) vehicles ply on alternate days of the scheme.

During the last 15 years, pollution has increased fast in Delhi but the Modi Government has been taking concrete steps to prevent pollution after holding meetings with the Ministers and Officers of neighboring states. Shri Javadekar said that it is very unfortunate that Kejriwal Government is doing politics on the issue of pollution and instigating the students to write letters to the Chief Ministers of Haryana and Punjab and trying to vilify them. It will not only create malice among the children but it will also be dangerous to use the children for political purposes. The CPCB has sent 45 teams in various areas of Delhi NCR which are advising about various ways to control pollution so that positive results may be possible. Mentioning about various steps taken by Modi Government for the prevention of pollution Shri Javadekar said that the Central Government is watching the industries polluting Delhi 24 hours. 3000 industries using fossil fuels have been converted into PNG using industries. 3000 brick kilns have been changed into zigzag system. In addition, Modi Government had also expanded the Metro network and today the Metro network of Delhi is of 300 kilometers in which 50 lakh people travel every day. It has helped in protecting environment and controlling pollution. But it is unfortunate that Kejriwal Government did not release its share of fund for the expansion of Metro network and court had to intervene. Appealing to all the agencies engaged in controlling pollution, Shri Javadekar said that all the agencies need to work for the prevention of pollution so that the people may get relief. Shri Javadekar further said that in place of accusing others, Delhi Government should take concrete steps for controlling pollution. Since Kejriwal Government is losing its political base it has forgotten service to humanity and it is doing everything for vote politics which it should not do. बाहरी उत्तरी दिल्ली के बवाना इलाके में एक महिला की हत्या करने के बाद उसके शव को सूटकेस में डालकर फेंकने के आरोप में पुलिस ने तीन लोगों को गिरफ्तार किया है।

पुलिस ने शनिवार को बताया कि गिरफ्तार लोगों की पहचान नोएडा के रहने वाले नोमान (30), शक्रपुर गांव के रहने वाले अरमान (26) और न्यू उस्मानपुर के रहने वाले शमशाद (30) के तौर पर हुई है। पुलिस के अनुसार, महिला का शव 18 अक्टूबर की सुबह बवाना में लावारिस पड़े एक सूटकेस में मिला था।

सीसीटीवी फुटेज की जांच में यह खुलासा हुआ कि ऑटोरिक्षा में आ रहे किसी व्यक्ति ने सूटकेस को वहां फेंका था। पुलिस के एक



वरिष्ठ अधिकारी ने बताया कि मृतका की पहचान शक्रपुर गांव की रहने वाली नेहा पटेल के तौर पर हुई है जो 18 अक्टूबर से लापता थी। पिछले एक महीने से वह किसी लुकमान के साथ रह रही थी।

मेट्रो सेवा फिर बाधित, नोएडा-गाजियाबाद व दिल्ली के लोग परेशान

दिल्ली-एनसीआर को लाइफ लाइन बन चुकी दिल्ली मेट्रो ने शनिवार को एक बार फिर लोगों को परेशान कर दिया। समाचार एजेंसी एनआइ के मुताबिक, एक बार फिर तकनीकी दिक्कतों के चलते यूपी के नोएडा-गाजियाबाद शहर और दिल्ली के द्वारका के बीच चलने वाली ब्लू लाइन मेट्रो में दिक्कत आई है। इससे यात्रियों को परेशानी का सामना करना पड़ रहा है।
वहीं, दोपहर में इंद्रप्रस्था से प्रगति मैदान के बीच भी दिक्कत पेश आई है, जिससे यात्री परेशान हुए। मेट्रो अधिकारियों के मुताबिक, मॉडर्निस वर्क के चलते यह दिक्कत पेश आ रही है। वहीं, ब्लू लाइन के इस स्ट पर दिक्कत के चलते गाजियाबाद के यात्रियों को भी परेशान हो रही है। पीक आवर में आई दिक्कत ने लोगों के समय पर दफ्तर पर पहुंचने की चुनौती बढ़ा दी। गौरतलब की ब्लू लाइन दिल्ली में मेट्रो



को सबसे व्यस्त लाइन है। दिल्ली, नोएडा और गाजियाबाद के लोग सबसे ज्यादा सफर करते हैं। ऐसे में ब्लू लाइन मेट्रो में तकनीकी खराबी सबसे ज्यादा यात्रियों को प्रभावित करती है। वहीं, ब्लू लाइन पर द्वारका से इलेक्ट्रॉनिक सिटी नोएडा की ओर जा रही मेट्रो के एक कोच में अचानक स्पाइकिंग होने से धुआं निकलने लगा। दोपहर डेढ़ बजे हुई इस घटना से ट्रेन में अफरातफरी मच गई। यात्रियों ने इसकी शिकायत ट्रेन ऑपरेटर से की। जिसके बाद आरके आश्रम स्टेशन पर मेट्रो को रोककर उसे खाली कराया गया।

मेट्रो को खाली कराने के बाद उसे यमुना बैंक डिपो भेज दिया गया। यात्रियों के अनुसार, मेट्रो में पहले से ही कुछ तकनीकी खराबी थी। आरके आश्रम स्टेशन पर इस मेट्रो ट्रेन को खाली कराए जाने के दौरान इसके पीछे ब्लू लाइन पर मेट्रो ट्रेने भी रुक गई। इसके अलावा आरके आश्रम स्टेशन पर यात्रियों की भीड़ बढ़ गयी।
इस घटना के कारण ब्लू लाइन पर करीब आधा घंटा मेट्रो की रफ्तार धीमी रही। दिल्ली मेट्रो रेल निगम (डीएमआरसी) ने मेट्रो में धुआं उठाने से इन्कार किया है। डीएमआरसी का कहना है कि मेट्रो के कोच में ब्रेक से संबंधित परेशानी थी। बता दें कि दिल्ली-एनसीआर की लाइफ लाइन दिल्ली मेट्रो ट्रेनों का संचालन दिल्ली मेट्रो रेल निगम द्वारा किया जाता है। एक अनुमान के मुताबिक, दिल्ली, गुरुग्राम, नोएडा, गाजियाबाद, फरीदाबाद के 30 लाख से अधिक यात्री मेट्रो में रोजाना सफर करते हैं।
